Figure 6: Different types of stakeholder participation (Adapted from Bouamrame 2006)

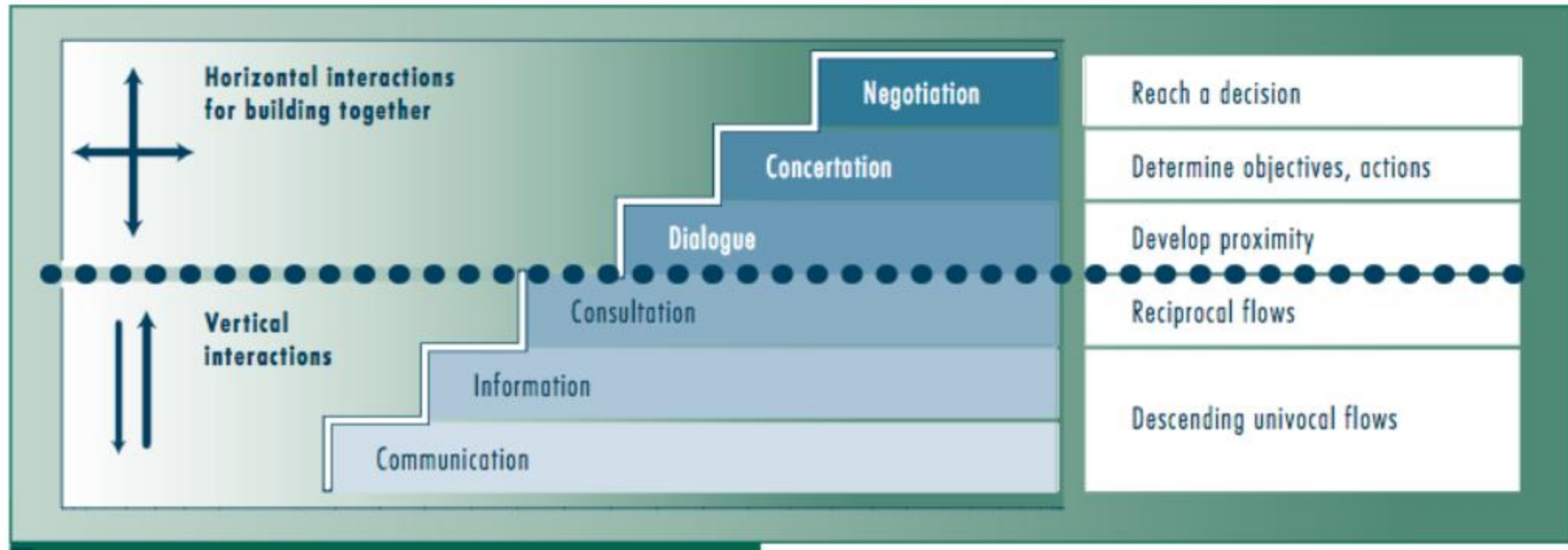
